

NOTICE TO BIDDERS GREENVILLE DOWNTOWN AIRPORT AIRFIELD LIGHTING REHABILITATION PROJECT

The GREENVILLE DOWNTOWN AIRPORT will receive sealed proposals for the 2017 AIRFIELD LIGHTING REHABILITATION PROJECT at the Greenville Downtown Airport, FAA AIP Project No. 3-45-0026-026-2017. Proposals will be received in the conference room of the Greenville Downtown Airport, 100 Tower Drive, Unit 2, Greenville, South Carolina 29607 until 2:00 P.M (Local Time) on June 14, 2018 at which time and place bids will be publicly opened and read aloud. Bids received after the stated time will not be accepted.

SCOPE OF WORK

This project generally consists of runway and taxiway lighting and electrical improvements for the Greenville Downtown Airport. Improvements will include the following:

- Base Bid Runway 1-19 High Intensity Runway Lighting (HIRL)
 - Demolition of approximately 80 existing runway lights and regulators, circuits, PAPI
 - 80 New High Intensity Runway Edge or Threshold Lights (HIRLs)
 - New circuits and conduit
 - New duct banks and junction can plazas
 - New 12'x20' prefabricated lighting vault building and vault equipment
 - New Precision Approach Path Indicator System (PAPIs)
 - New Runway End Identifier Lights (REILs)
 - Owner paid option to upgrade runway lights to LED
- Additive Bid No. 1 Runway 1 MALSF Rehabilitation
 - Demolition of old Medium Intensity Approach Lighting System with flashers components (MALSF)
 - New MALSF lights, control cabinets, cabling, transformer and other equipment
 - Refurbish existing MALSF towers
- Additive Bid No. 2 Taxiways A & B Medium Intensity Taxiway Lights (MITLs)
 - Demolition of approximately 480 existing taxiway or helipad lights and cabling
 - Approximately 540 New Medium Intensity Taxiway or Helipad Lights (MITLs)
 - Approximately 40,000 LF of new conduit, cable, counterpoise, junction can plazas

The maximum contract time for the project if all bid schedules are awarded is 160 calendar days. The project will also include several phases, some of which will require night work.

PREBID CONFERENCE

There will be a **NON-MANDATORY** pre-bid conference held at the Greenville Downtown Airport Terminal Building, 100 Tower Drive, Greenville, SC 29607 on **May 24, 2018 at 10:00 AM**. Attendance by Prime Contractors is **NOT** required to bid on this project. The purpose of the conference is to highlight the Project, explain pertinent FAA regulations as well as the Airport's safety, security and procurement processes and complete a site visit.

BIDDING REQUIREMENTS

Bid security in the form of a bid bond, made payable to the Greenville Airport Commission, Greenville, South Carolina, equal to 5% of the total bid is required. Contract security in the form of 100% Performance and Payment Bonds will be required.

No bid may be withdrawn after closing time for the receipt of proposals for a period of one hundred and twenty (120) days. A Notice-of-Award for the Contract will be issued once a successful bidder has been determined and funding and permits have been secured.
